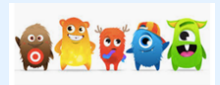

GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2025

Following on from this year's Dursley and Wotton District Cross Country races, a team of 40 Year 5 and 6 boys and girls were chosen to represent our district at the Gloucestershire County Championships, held in Cheltenham on 9th March. George S, Verity S & Ieuan M were selected to compete.

There were four challenging races, each with 70 athletes (10 from each of the seven districts) competing on a hilly course against the county's top junior athletes. It was a tough competition, but they all did their very best, with George finishing 31st, Verity in 44th & Ieuan 33rd.

The top 10 finishers gained an invitation to compete at the National finals in Coventry.

They all really enjoyed the challenge and should feel incredibly proud of themselves.

ZONES OF REGULATION

If your child has been talking about their emotions in terms of colours recently it is because we have been slowly introducing 'Zones of Regulation' into school (see an example in the diagram). This is an easy way to think and talk with children about how they feel on the inside, sorting emotions into 4 coloured zones. We hope to enable children to regulate their emotions more independently and to revise our behaviour policy in the future to reflect these. Attached with this newsletter is an NHS leaflet that explains the concept in more detail. We will introduce this more fully to parents/carers towards the end of this school year and the beginning of the next.
