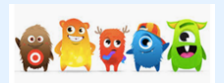

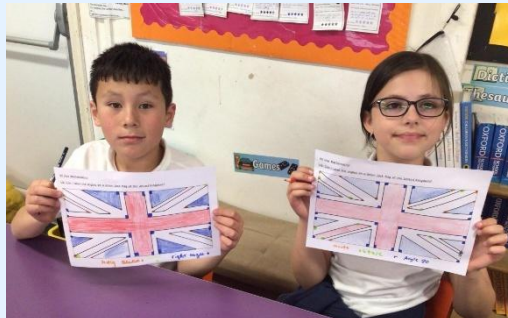


VE DAY 80 YEARS CELEBRATIONS

Here a few snippets of Cam Hopton's VE Day celebrations yesterday!

Year 4 researched the causes and consequences of WW2, looked at what it was like to be a child during wartime, talked about the evacuees that came to Cam Hopton, found out about how Princess Elizabeth secretly celebrated VE Day on the streets of London with her sister, Princess Margaret, and watched historic footage of VE Day.

As part of our VE themed day, we investigated the internal angles in the Union Jack for our maths lesson, made Union Jack celebration wristbands and used embossing and engraving techniques to create VE Day commemorative coins!



Reception Class watched a video of VE Day street parties and then created flags, bunting and wristbands. In the afternoon they had their own party, had some treats and danced the afternoon away!
