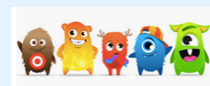

It is very important to check your child's ParentPay account and make sure any outstanding debts are cleared **before the end of term please.**

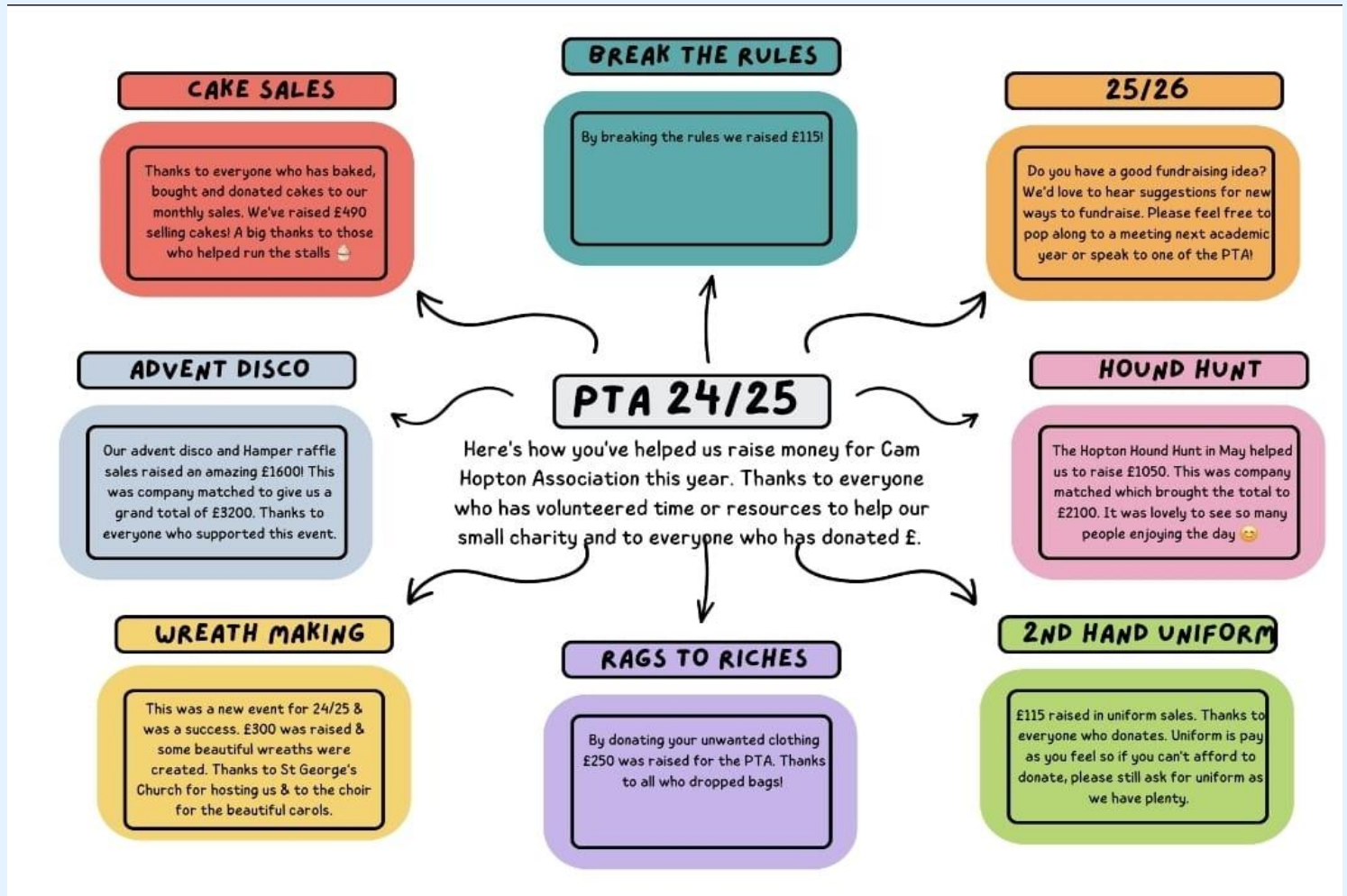
Any debt left outstanding will be absorbed by school meaning less funds being spent on children where they are really needed.
