Terms of Reference

Responsibilities

The main function of the committee is to support, advise and challenge the Head Teacher and Governors on matters relating to the distinctiveness and effectiveness of Cam Hopton as a church school and the impact that has on the pupils and the whole school community in particular:

- The impact of the school's Christian vision on the whole school community and how this permeates throughout the school
- The distinctively Christian foundation of the school's vision, the provision the school makes because of this vision and how effective this provision is in enabling all pupils to flourish, leading to "Life in all its fullness"
- The impact of worship on the whole school community
- The relationship between the school and St George's Church Cam
- The development of joint projects between school and church, such as a shared charity
- The relationship between the school and the local, national and global communities: the school community's understanding of Global citizenship
- The impact and effectiveness of religious education within the school community
- The impact of Christian values within the curriculum and on the wider life of the school
- The way in which the school makes provision for the future leadership of the school as a church school
- The way in which the Christian character of the school is monitored and evaluated in terms of its impact on pupils, staff, parents and the wider community
- To make recommendations to the governing body on relevant policy matters
- Preparation for Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS)
- To co-ordinate feedback relating to the wellbeing of the school community to the FGB.
- Meet three times a year and report back to the FGB meetings.
