They suggested planting ‘colour’ – bluebells, snowdrops, bulbs – daffodils and tulips, strawberry plants. And sensory plants like Lavendar, Mint and Sage. Going to take advice from Ruby’s Mum who is a gardener.

The path needs starting again – remove the grey stones and make a path of suitable gravel. Area that is just a large sandy area – to get a tyre or large flat container and fill it with stones hand painted by pupils ?Yr6.

Move bench into the area.
