

Second meeting of Worship Council 9th March 2020

We considered questions based on what we had said Worship Council meant to us....

What would Jesus think about our school?

‘Jesus would be sad about our lack of caring for the environment’

We need more bins outside. And perhaps decorate them.

And we need to encourage one another to pick up rubbish - maybe a reward if you pick up rubbish? eg

‘every piece of rubbish found isextra time of playtime.

And needs more respect for each other - eg listening to each other more.

What can the Worship Council do to make the school more Christian?

In collective worships - OTB team to have greater involvement with younger children KS1 and know our lines to make us more professional?

- Worship Council to lead a Collective Worship about PRAYER and include in this a change to the prayer that is said before lunch.

How can we , the Worship Council, make the school a better place?

- Put up more positive prayers and use pictures for KS1
- Put Jesus story in pictures
- Put up the Lord’s Prayer
- Change prayer before lunch

What areas could be quiet spaces in school?

- INSIDE - Find an area in the hall as a focal point - eg the RE table and this could be a place to offer prayers
 - Give each child a piece of patchwork and sew together to make a prayer quilt
 - put up more stained glass windows
 - put up prayers and change them weekly
 - have a worship / prayer week
 - invite isingPOP again
- OUTSIDE - Have a prayer space inside the OUTSIDE classroom
 - Worship council would design what this looks like
 - Look at the rules associated with the Outside Space being a quiet space during playtime
 - Erect a large cross in the playground / field
