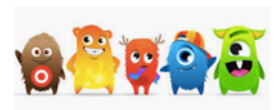

Library Books

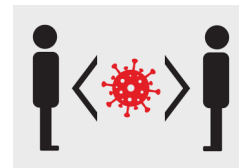

Tik Tok

Important Warning About Tik Tok

Gloucestershire Police are aware of a video circulating on the social media platform Tik Tok and other platforms such as Facebook, Instagram and Snapchat which shows a male taking his own life. For parents/carers awareness, the still of this video is of a male with a beard, seated at a desk. Whilst social media platforms have removed the original video, it has been widely re-shared and some users are embedding the video within others to trick users into watching it.

Gloucestershire Police would like to remind parents/carers that most social media apps, including Snapchat, Instagram and Tik Tok, are not suitable for people under the age of 13 due to the nature of some of the content shared on these platforms, including this video. We would also urge individuals to report any harmful content they come across on social media to the provider.
