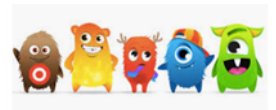

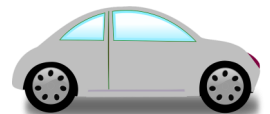

Parking

We have received a number of complaints from our neighbours in nearby Millbank who have asked us to remind parents to park considerately at all times. BREAK THE RULES
