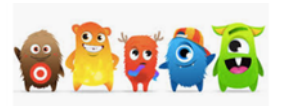

Christmas Plans at Cam Hopton

The staff and PTA at Cam Hopton want to make this time of year as special as possible for the children, whilst continuing to mitigate risks posed by Covid-19. We started with the Wizard of Oz pantomime and there are more activities planned, but with some changes to the norm:

Christmas Cards: Children are welcome to bring cards to school for CHILDREN IN THEIR CLASS ONLY. To minimise risk there will be a three day window each week when cards can be brought to school, then left for two days and distributed on Fridays. Cards can be brought in on the following days:

Monday 7th Dec to Weds 9th Dec and Monday 14th Dec to Weds 16th Dec

Christmas Parties: Teachers will organise these in the last week of term beginning the 14th December. We will not be asking for any food from home this year. Please look out for messages on Class Dojo and Parentmail.

PTA Christmas Fayre Day: Friday 11th December: Our wonderful PTA are organising a day just for children in school, full of games, stalls and an opportunity to visit Santa's Grotto. The PTA will be asking for a voluntary donation for this, but every child will have an opportunity to take part in their separate bubbles. Please look out for more information.

Christmas Jumper Days 1 and 2: The 'official' day is Friday 11th December. Children can wear their jumpers on this day but we won't be asking for donations to charity, because this is also Fayre Day. On Friday 18th December (last day of school), children can wear non-uniform/Christmas Jumpers again and donate a £1 towards Save the Children if they wish to.
