HALF TERM AND INSET DAY

We break up for Half Term on Friday 12th February and children who are in school at the moment will be able to return on Tuesday 23rd February. Monday 22nd February is a planned INSET day for teachers only.

Teachers will not be providing remote learning packs for use during half term, so that they and children can have a break, but they will prepare packs to be picked up on Friday 12th February to be used in the week following half term.

You will probably have seen the Government's announcement that they will consider a full return to school for primary aged children from the 8th March. This would be two weeks after we return from Half Term. However, presently we have no more information about this and it is unlikely that there will be any confirmation before we return from Half Term. As soon as we know the way forward we will let you know too.

REMOTE LEARNING LIVE LESSONS

We hope that many of our children have been able to access some live lessons over the past few weeks. Whilst things do not always go to plan, teachers are trying to include either live or recorded sessions in their Remote Learning planning, where appropriate to the age of the children, in addition to having some *screen free* days.

To make the most of this, it is really important that children behave appropriately in these lessons, so that the teachers can feel confident that everyone is safe and taking part. Whilst supervising your children please remind them:

- To mute themselves unless they are asking or answering a question
- Not to use the live chat facility unless a teacher instructs them to
- To stay in front of the screen
