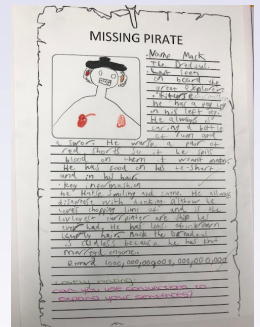

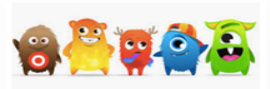

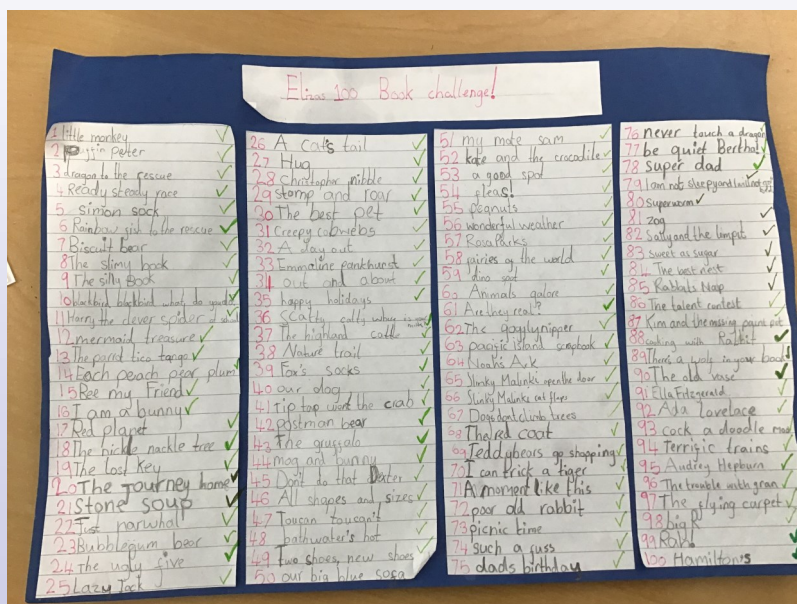

Introducing Your School Governors

*.... the governing body holds the head teacher to account for the educational performance of the **school** and its pupils, and for the performance management of staff.*

Different roles and what they mean:-

Parent Governor - Elected onto the governing body. Parent Governors are not representatives of parents but, hold the unique position of having an overall parental viewpoint of the school.

Foundation Governor - Foundation Governors are representatives of the Church of England on the Governing Body. They endeavour to cultivate respect for the spiritual and moral beliefs of the Christian tradition, and to create a community in which pupils, cared for as individuals, are helped to find fulfilment as they grow towards adulthood.

Chair - Works with and manages the Governing body to ensure the team support the head teacher to promote and maintain high standards of educational achievement.

Vice Chair - The primary role of the Vice-Chair is to support the Chair and where appropriate, to lead the Governing Body in their absence.

Clerk - The clerk's role is to provide an administrative resource for the governors and to ensure the smooth running of its functions, processes and meetings.
