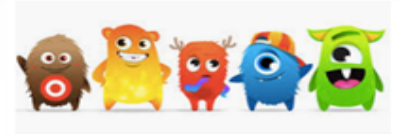

## KEEPING COVID SAFE- LATEST GUIDANCE FOR SCHOOLS

Following the government announcement on Monday, there is no change to operational guidance for schools. All control measures should remain in place until the end of term and regular Lateral Flow (LFD) testing for staff should continue.

In the event of a Covid case in school, government advice now is that any close contact of a PCR positive case is asked to take a PCR test to assist in containing the spread of Covid beyond the original setting. If parents and staff are willing then they can book their children for a PCR test through the NHS Portal <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>.

Everyone who takes a PCR test must continue in self isolation even if they receive a negative result. If they test positive with no symptoms, their 10 day isolation would commence again from the date of that test and their whole household must go into self isolation.

A positive LFD test should be treated in the same way as a positive PCR, in the first instance, and close contacts should self isolate. If a confirmatory PCR is received, then the isolation should continue. If a negative PCR result is received, all close contacts can return to school along with the original case.

Please be aware that there seems to be a delay between the change in Public Health advice detailed above and the scripts being used by the DfE helpline. You may receive conflicting advice but the above guidance should be adhered to.
