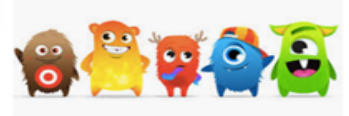

Junk Modelling Competition

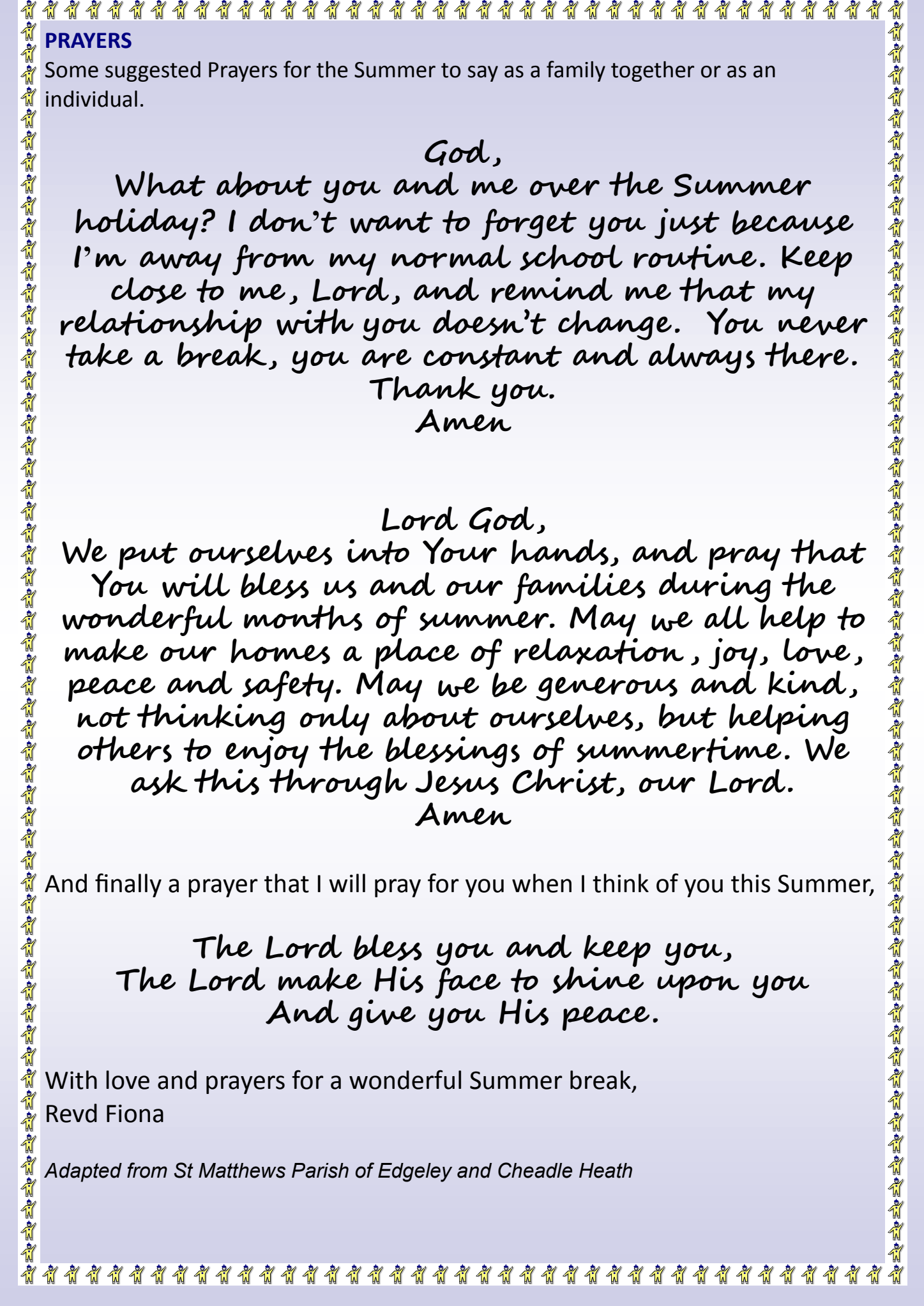
Which British Landmark do you like the best?
