'LIFE IN ALL ITS FULLNESS' CURRICULUM

Last Friday, as part of our 'Life in all its Fullness' curriculum, the whole school learnt new skills. Ash Randall, a Guinness World Record holder, inspired the children during assembly showing his incredible freestyle football skills. Some of the children and teachers were challenged to learn a new football skill. Each class got to have an extra session to learn some tips and techniques to develop their freestyle skills.

Some of Ash's achievements include:-

- Juggling a football for 13.1 miles during Cardiff Half Marathon.
- Climbing 42 floors and 932 stairs while balancing a football on the back up Tower 42.
- Breaking a Guinness World Record on Live TV in China in front of over 50 Million people.
- Juggling a football on the roof of a moving car down Cardiff Airport runway to set a new Guinness World Record.
- Performed in over 30 countries around the world.
- UK Freestyle Champion with, Pringles, Gillette, Seat, PES & ITV.

We think the children loved it!!

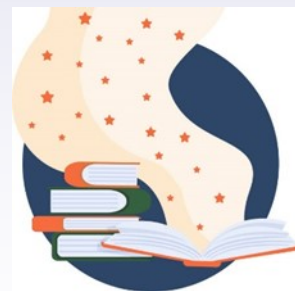


FLU IMMUNISATION SPRAY—THURSDAY 17th NOVEMBER
