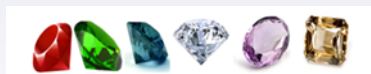

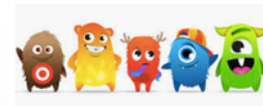

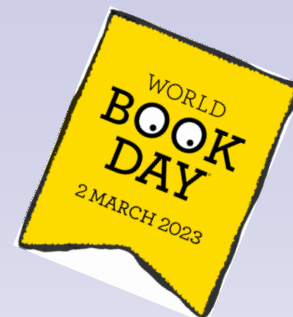
World Book Day (Thursday 2nd March) at Cam Hopton... Lots to look forward to!

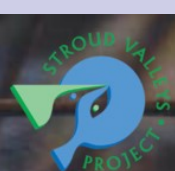
