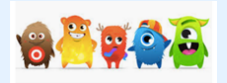

LANGUAGES AT CAM HOPTON

Hi there,

Mrs Hicks here! I wanted to give an update on languages at Cam Hopton and tell you a little more of what we have been up to.

As a school, we have chosen French as our main language for children to learn over their KS2 journey. We teach this through a programme called Rigalo and KS2 classes have a lesson once a week. We are also trying to build into our curriculum more opportunities for a range of languages to be heard and spoken, as well as experiences for children.

We have chosen to launch a language of the year and this year it is-Japanese!

Children in languages club have been learning some basic phrases and counting to 10. They have also been very busy making and eating Japanese food! Children who have been to languages club were very enthusiastic and were keen to share what they have learnt.
