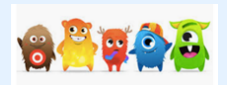

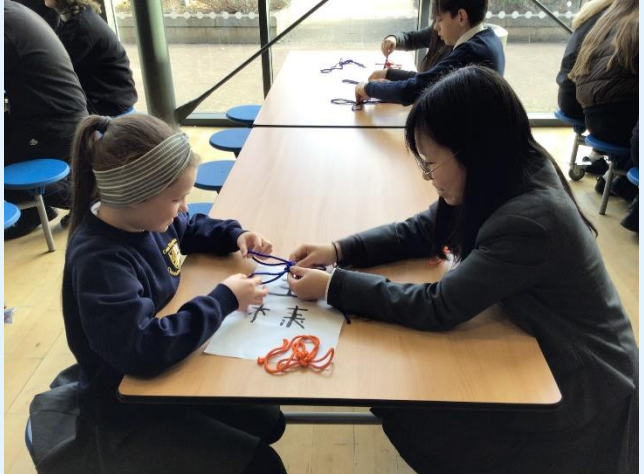
PARENTS' EVENINGS – TUESDAY 30TH JAN & THURSDAY 1ST FEB
