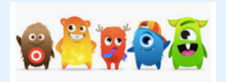

This is a great opportunity for girls who are new to rugby to give it a try, as well as those who already come on a Sunday.

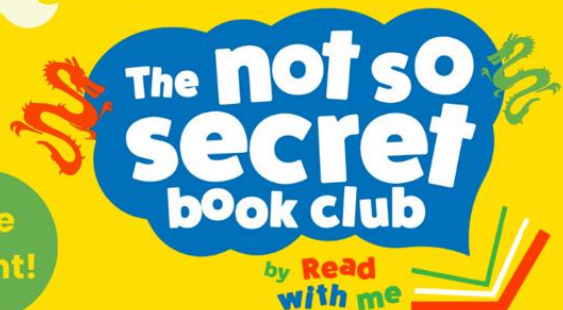
READ WITH ME
