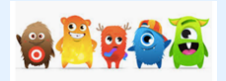

NEW for 2024! Dedicated sessions for primary school aged girls, at Rednock Sports Centre. They start on Wednesday 17th January at 5pm.

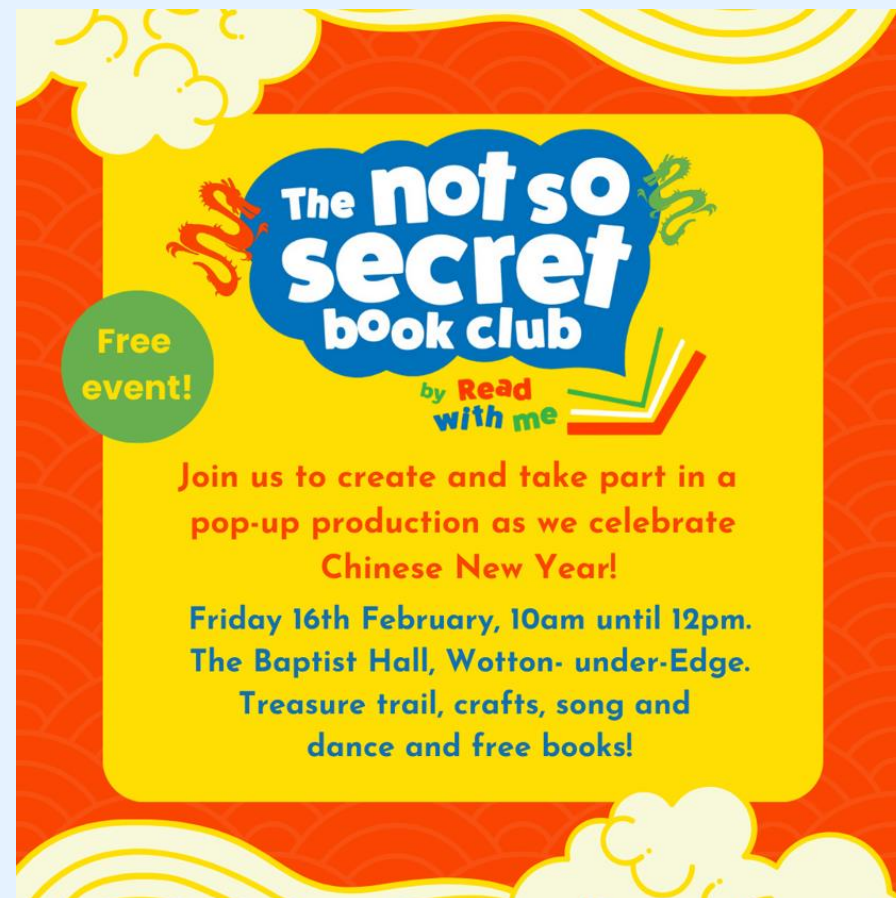
This is a great opportunity for girls who are new to rugby to give it a try, as well as those who already come on a Sunday.
