

<u>Overview of Units</u> <u>Year 1</u>	
1.1	<u>U/C - GOD: What do Christians believe God is like?</u> Christians believe the Bible reveals what God is like. For example Christians use parables in a variety of ways as comfort, inspiration and challenge. Unit has focus on the parable of the Lost Son and the story of Jonah. (Includes ideas for teaching prayer using 'Peter Praise, Suzy Sorry, Andrew Ask and Thea Thanks'.)
1.2	<u>U/C - CREATION: Who made the World? Harvest</u> The story of creation in the Bible sets out the relationship between God, the universe and all life. It reveals God as powerful, creative, orderly and concerned with the role and value of life. Unit focuses on Genesis 1:1 - 2:3, Harvest, saying grace at meal times, the importance of resting.
1.7	<u>Glos Syllabus - 1.7 - Who is Jewish and how do they live?</u> <u>(double unit)</u> This unit looks at the everyday life of people from Jewish communities. It looks at special objects used within the religion and festivals and stories that are celebrated and read.
1.9	<u>Glos Syllabus - 1.9 - How should we care for others and the world and why does it matter?</u> This unit talks about how each person is unique and important. It discusses the benefits and responsibilities of friendship and the ways in which people care for each other. It goes on to look at the ways that people could and should look after the world that God created.
1.10	<u>Glos Syllabus - 1.10 - What does it mean to belong to a faith community?</u> This unit looks at belonging to different groups and religions and some of the symbols used to show that you belong. The unit goes on to look at Baptism/Marriage and naming ceremonies used in other faiths. Finally the unit looks at how people from different faith groups and indeed no faith group can work alongside each other to benefit others.
